

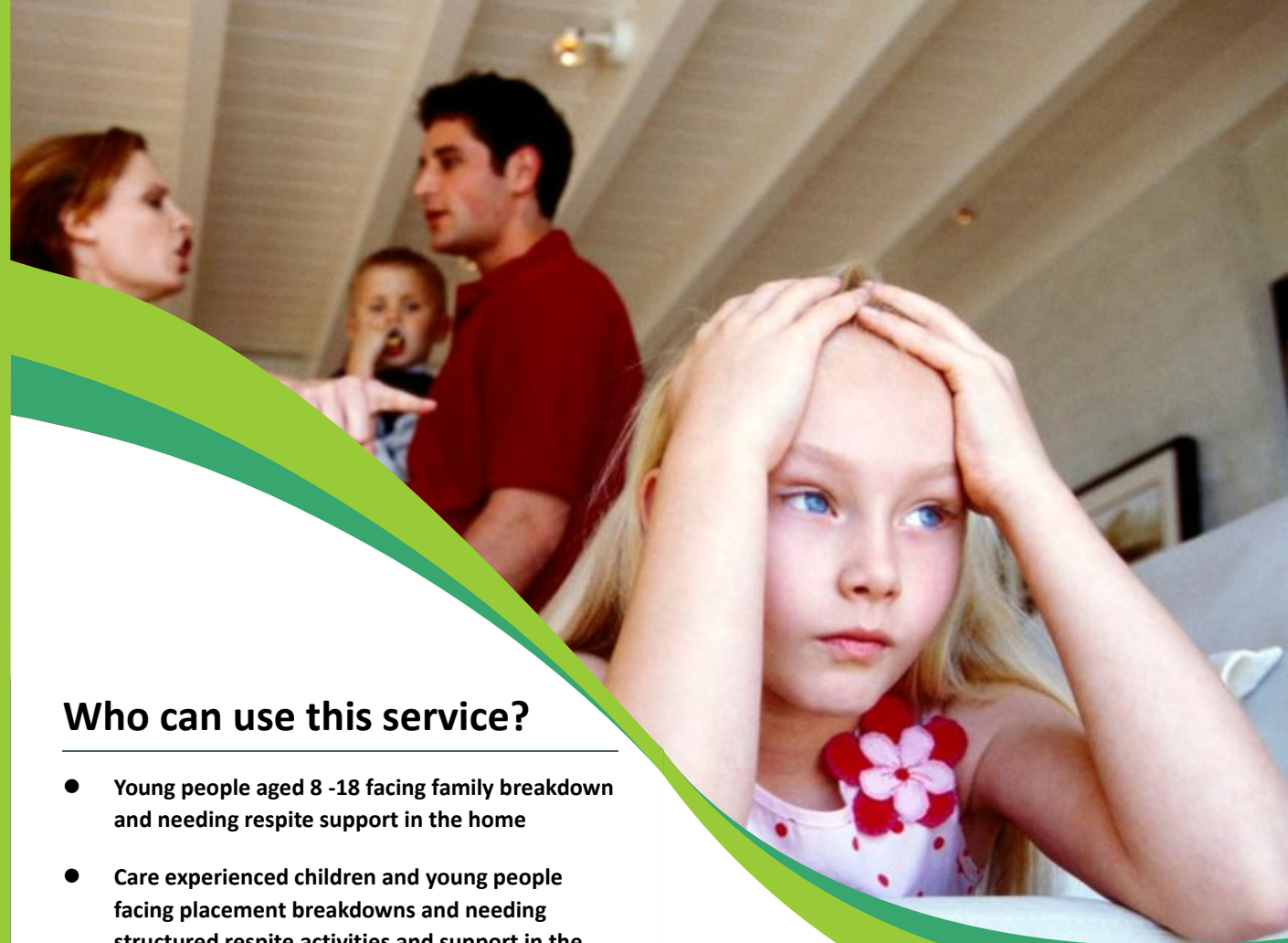
What we provide:

Immediate Response to Crisis: The service prioritises a rapid response for young people who are experiencing acute difficulties, such as a breakdown in their family setting, current care placement, or homelessness.

Stabilisation and Transition: Once the immediate crisis is managed, the support team works to stabilise the young person's situation. This includes, addressing any underlying issues, such as trauma or a lack of essential life skills, to help them prepare for the next stage of their accommodation or permanence plan.

24-Hour Availability: The service is equipped to offer up to 24 hours of direct support in situations where the young person's needs are particularly high. This includes around-the-clock supervision and guidance from skilled staff members trained in managing crisis situations and de-escalating conflicts.

Holistic Care Approach: Emergency Outreach Support also focuses on fostering emotional resilience and improving the young person's coping mechanisms. This holistic approach includes assistance with everyday tasks, emotional support, and collaboration with other professionals (e.g., social workers, healthcare providers) to ensure that the young person's short-term needs are addressed whilst a permanence plan is drawn up.

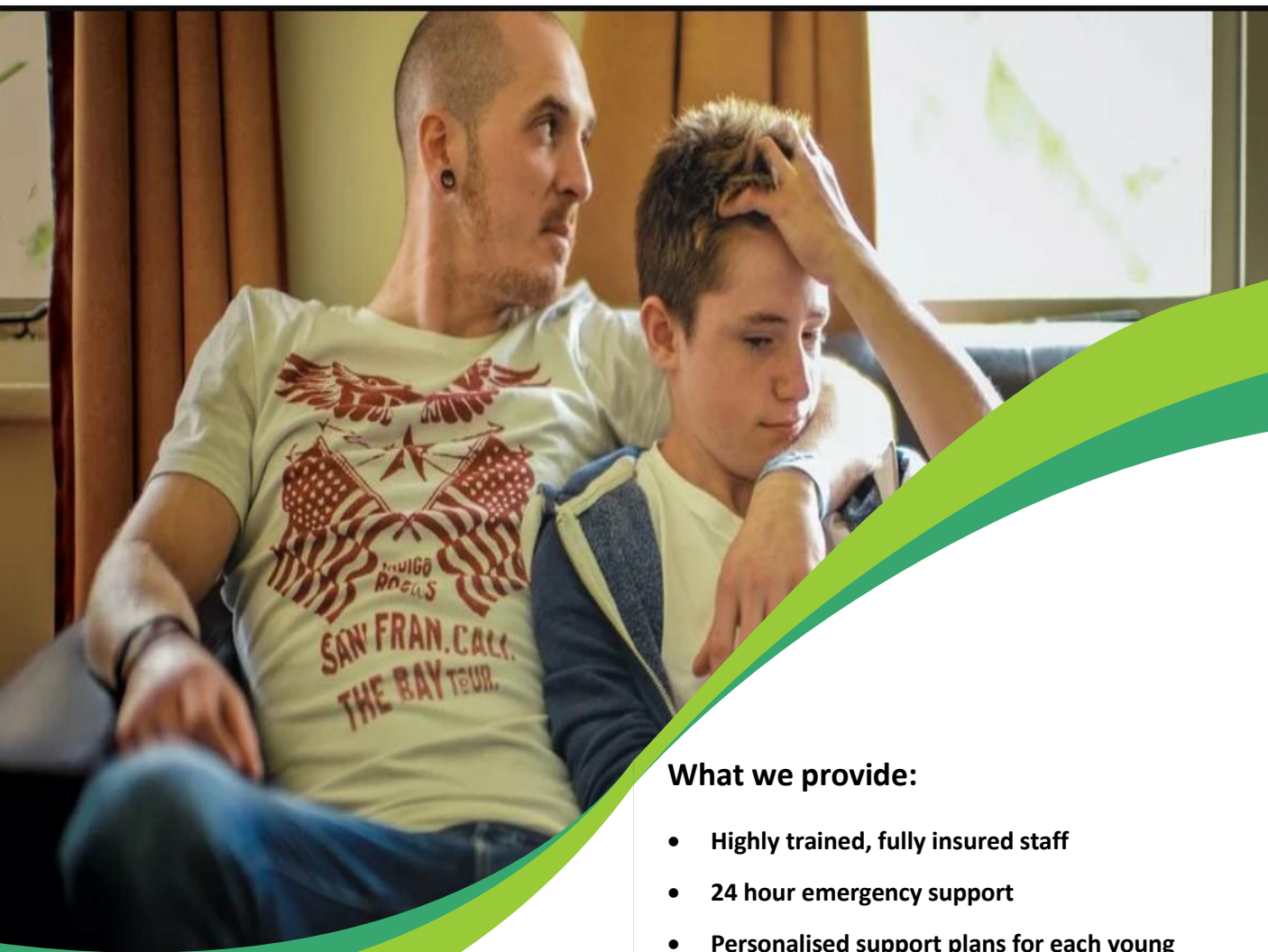


Who can use this service?

- Young people aged 8 -18 facing family breakdown and needing respite support in the home
- Care experienced children and young people facing placement breakdowns and needing structured respite activities and support in the home or community.
- Emergency Support: Intensive support ranging from 15 to 24 hours per week for children and young people with complex needs requiring emergency accommodation.
- Medium - High Level Support: Up to 15 hours of direct support per week for young people in solo placements who have significant support needs and limited independence skills.
